

## Village of Cambria Board Meeting

Minutes for April 7, 2026

6:30pm

### **Call to Order: Mark, Marshall, Robby, Robin, Mike and Suzzette**

**Approve the Minutes** for March 18,2026: Robin made a Motion, and Mark 2<sup>nd</sup> the Motion. Rollcall, and ALL in favor.

**Trustees Approve Disbursements** paid out to Vendors and Employees. Robin made Motion, 2<sup>nd</sup> was made by Mike to authorize the disbursements paid in the amount of the agenda from April 7, 2026. Rollcall, and All in favor of the motion

**Approve Executive Session** Minutes from March 18, 2026, Amended, to “*Discussion was made*”, then Motion made by Marshall, 2<sup>nd</sup> Motion made by Suzzette R/C, ALL Yes.

**Guest Speaker on Agenda: Doris Harrison**, asked if The Village of Cambria wanted to sponsor her newsletter with a 2x2 ad, and spoke of Hurst Activities coming up. **Renee Kidd**, spoke about what she learned from Amanda Barnes, in the fact that she does not research candidates, and The Village needed to implement a research process for candidacy and that they were vetted and found to be able to sit on the board. She spoke of her daughters’ interest to see the Village succeed and that she was the future of the TOWN as well Renee spoke of her interest in the Municipal Clerk position. **Scott Pellegrino** claimed that lies had been made, regarding the process to remove a board member from their chair, due to his research, at the State Attorney level. Pellegrino was upset with the Board; due to the fact they would not be voting on the Mayor/President position on this night, like he was told previously. Mr. Smith claimed that the applicants needed to be vetted, and confirmed the applicants met the legal requirements before a vote. Pellegrino asked for a Special Election for Mayor/President, Mr. Smith said that election would be held April 2027, that there was no provision in the statue for a Special Election. **Megan Krumrey** came with many questions for certain board members, mainly why 3 Board members who voted against Robby Chitwood for Mayor the past times. Krumrey wanted to know why they voted the way they did. Krumrey wanted to know what Tif money was used for? Mr. Hagler addressed the question, with the infrastructure Water, Sewer, and Street upkeep. She wanted to be able to trust in the Board because it faces nonpartisan decisions.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Tabled, Proposed Tif District 3 Inducement Resolution, Nic Nelson was not present. Ryan Aloffen said he would build on 24 acres, residential homes. Mr. Smith said Annex would come 1<sup>st</sup>.

Motion by Suzzette to approve Mandated Abandonment of 6” water line on Williamson County right of way (under & within round about construction area, includes easement work. Mr. Hagler said Tif or Motor Fuel could not be used for this expense. 2<sup>nd</sup> was Mike. R/C. ALL Yes.

Tabled, Lots for Tax Increment, due to Eli Birka not being present.

Tabled Approval with Rend Lake Water District Ten Year-Contract, due to working out the contract.

Motion by Mark to approve a Re-Vote for Robby Chitwood for President/Mayor. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike. R/C. Mark, YES, Marshall, NO, Suzette, NO, Robby, YES, Robin, NO, Mike, YES. Motion did not carry.

Tabled, Discuss/Adjust compensation of certain employees.

No motion made regarding Delinquency Bill of Trustee because the President/Mayor said it was under investigation.

No motion made regarding Shredding of Village Financial document by Trustee because the President/Mayor said it was under investigation.

No motion was made for The Village of Cambria to pay for the survey, to find proof of annexation of the home done in 1996 where Marshall Brown resides with his parents, due to Marshall, asking what firm, and claiming no one has got in touch with his Parents, and it was not legal to do without permission and expect Browns to pay for survey if the home doesn't.

Marshall made motion to Give Fire Department \$50,000.00 for a Brush Truck. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike. R/C. ALL YES.

Robin motioned for the White Police Car behind City Hall be given to Fire Department, and Randell said Tyler Bailey would donate an engine, and he would speak with Jim Morris about putting it in the donated car. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Suzette. R/C. ALL, YES.

Marshall motioned to Pay for the Boil Water Advisory Signs Mr. Hagler previously ordered. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike. R/C. ALL, YES.

Robin motioned to Approve Execution of OSLAD \$197,000.00 Grant Agreement, and give Marshall Brown power to sign the agreement. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike. R/C. ALL, YES.

Suzette motioned to Vacate the Alleyway at the end of Tyner Lane. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Robin. R/C. ALL, YES.

Robin reported that she would not be asking for \$50.00 every month for BINGO, due to the condition of the Village of Cambria Cafeteria.
